
CHRISTMAS MESSAGE

TEXT: LUKE 2:8-20

BIBLE REFERENCES: ISAIAH 9:6-7, MATTHEW 1:21-23, JOHN 21:25; 20:30, MATTHEW 15:29



The topic, *"Don't be afraid, there is good news of salvation for everyone"* was a message from an angel to a group of shepherd who were watching their sheep in the middle of the night. Everything that God does, it is done in such a way that it clears everyone's conscience. The angel who brought the message didn't go to some set of persons well known, but to shepherds and this is because Jesus Christ

was coming to live the life of a shepherd – the good shepherd for that matter.

"There were some shepherds in that part of the country who were spending the night in the fields, taking care of their flocks. An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of God shown over them. They were terribly afraid, but the angel said to them, 'Don't be afraid! I am here with good news for you, which will bring great joy to all the people. This day in David's town your Saviour was born – Christ the Lord!" Luke 2:8-11
