**THANKSGIVING TO GOD ALMIGHTY FOR THE SUCCESS OF UROMI 4 DAYS
CRUSADE AT THE INT'L H/Q, WARRI.**

TOPIC: *LET US PRAISE GOD FOR HIS MIGHTY ACTS*

PREACHER: *BISHOP JESUTEKEVWE SAMUEL MIYERIJESU*

TEXT: *PSALMS 150:1&2*



Today is a great day that the Lord has arranged for us to give Him praise for the mighty acts he has done in our lives. Let us praise Him for His mighty acts.

‘Let us...’ is a call to all to come and praise God for His mighty acts.

What is an act? It means deed; something someone

has done. Our God has done mighty deeds in our lives. Not just deed but mighty deeds; wonderful things.

In Psalm 150:1&2, the text of the topic; King David said, *Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power. Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness.*



As a matter of fact, the acts of God in our lives are mighty; so mighty that no amount of praise to God could equate them. David testified: **Who can utter the mighty acts of the LORD? Who can shew forth all his praise? From the Living Bible Translation, it says: Who can list the things the Lord has done?** In the great things the Lord has done for us cannot be counted.

Have you ever imagined! You would have died long ago were it not for the great acts of the Lord. The sicknesses, accidents, challenges that killed others came to you but the Lord made you to go through successfully. We cannot praise God enough considering His mighty works in our lives.

A song-writer wrote:

Through all eternity to thee
A joyful song I'll raise
For O, eternity's too short
To utter all thy praise.

The Song writer; inspired by the Holy Spirit, said "eternity is too short to utter all thy praise." This means for whom God is and for the miraculous works He daily wrought in our lives, we can't praise Him



In the history of the Bible, the Lord never disappointed those who put their trust in Him. He showed His mighty acts in the lives of those who faithfully served Him.

He delivered Daniel from the den of lions
He saved Shadrach Meshach and

Abednego from the power of fire

- He made Abraham to give birth at old age

- He raised Lazarus back to life after 4 days in the grave
- He miraculously brought Paul and Silas from prison
- He saved Peter from Prison
- With signs and wonders, he delivered the Israelites from Egypt, etc.

All of the above are the mighty acts of God. When Moses saw the mighty deeds of the Lord - how God dealt with king Pharaoh, and had his and all his soldiers killed in the red sea - he said in awe:

Who is like unto thee, O LORD, among the gods? who is like thee, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders? (Exo. 15:11).

Moses continued to wonder how mighty are the acts of the Lord upon their lives. So mighty that Pharaoh and his people attested to it. They said: “The Lord is fighting for the Israelites against us. Let us get out of here” Exo. 14:26). But then, it was already too late for them. They all died in the red sea while all the Israelites were saved. Seeing all of these, Moses became a song-composer. He composed songs to thank and praise God Almighty for his mighty acts (Exo. 15).

Just as God showed His mighty acts in the times of old as revealed in the above examples, so also He is doing today in the life of the Bishop of the whole world and our lives in general.

Like I said, if the mighty deeds of the Lord are to be counted, they cannot be exhausted.



All around us, we see the great things of the Lord. In our evangelical movements, the Lord has proved Himself mighty. Consider Uromi crusade (Friday 4th to Monday 6th Feb. 2017); the deeds of the Lord were beyond human understanding. The Lord delivered us from massacre killing and series of

accidents that would have claimed lives. The people of Uromi as a whole were convinced of the great power of God manifested through His son, Saint Dikeji Miyerijesu, the Bishop of the whole world. The sick were healed, the demonic oppressed were set free and unnumbered souls were saved, baptized and added to the Church.

As a matter of fact, till today, the fame of the mighty deeds of the Lord in Uromi town and other neighbouring villages and towns, in Edo State is still spreading. What a great and mighty God we serve! What about our individual lives? These mighty acts of the Lord are evident. In our marriages, education, finance, businesses, etc. we have seen the mighty works of the Lord.
